

Veglio Michelino e Figlio

Veglio Michelino e Figlio is a small, family-owned & operated vineyard located in the beautiful Piedmont region in northwestern Italy. Veglio Michelino e Figlio produces red and white wines by using traditional techniques with experience passed down from previous generations. The property includes more than 25 hectares, 20 of which are dedicated to the vineyards, while the rest are used to cultivate hazelnuts.

Rosso Sinfonia

Grape Variety: Dolcetto, Barbera, & Nebbiolo

Classification: Dry Red Table Wine

Production Zone: Diano d'Alba - Serralunga d'Alba - Montelupo Albese

Harvest: Grapes are picked manually throughout September and October.

Processing: Grapes are softly pressed and fermented at a controlled temperature. The wine is refined in stainless steel tanks for 6 months.

Alcohol Level: 11 - 12% by volume

Duration: At least 3 years

Characteristics:

This wine provides an intense and fruity aroma. It is a dry wine that is young, fruity and low in alcohol. The lovely blend of Dolcetto, Barbera and Nebbiolo grapes from Piedmont allow the wine to be enjoyed with everyday meals.

Rosso Sinfonia is an enjoyable and easy to drink wine that is best served at room temperature and can accompany various pasta dishes with tomato sauce, pizza and an assortment of cheeses.
